what we do

Throughout history, indigenous cultures understood the value of providing a marked and meaningful Rite of Passage experience, and elder mentorship to steward youngsters into healthy adulthood. Failing to do so saw youngsters going feral and beginning a perilous journey into social decline.

a**band**of**brothers** offer a grassroots, social action solution to the problem of young male disaffection. We connect, inspire, and train male volunteers to work with some of the most disadvantaged and (self-)destructive young men aged 18-25.

how we do it

Through Rite of Passage and mentoring services, a**band**of**brothers** helps young men find out what it takes to be a healthy man in today's world.

Offered as an alternative path to prison, addiction, violence and suicide, we support them to move away from misguided choices to create a life that holds meaning, purpose and belonging.

We create embedded mentoring communities woven into society around the UK, enabling men to reclaim social responsibility by stewarding them into healthy adulthood.

Bridging the generational gap between men is the first step towards bringing young men in from the fringes of society to build a life that is good for them and good for others. If the young are not initiated into the tribe they will burn down the village just to feel its warmth.
